Notice of Proposed Adoption of Ordinance  
and Public Hearing**

**ORDINANCE 20-10**

**An ordinance annexing 6 parcels of land consisting of approximately 3.416 acres of land located on Calle Elacio and Trujillo Lane and to amend the official zoning map to include the annexed properties with an R-2 “Single-Family Residential” and R-4 “Residential” Zoning Designation.**

Due to the Public Health Emergency declared by the Governor of New Mexico, initially declared under Executive Order 2020-004, the public health emergency issued by the New Mexico Department of Health, and the guideline set forth by the New Mexico Attorney General’s Office **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that on August 11, 2020, the Town of Taos Council, meeting in regular session through Zoom Video Conferencing at 4:00 P.M., will consider the adoption of the above referenced ordinance.

This *virtual meeting* will be a public hearing to consider the merits of the ordinance.
